- **Number Resource Organization**

- NRO MoU, 24 Oct 2003
- Lightweight, unincorporated association

- **Mission**

- Provide and promote a coordinated Internet number registry system
- Promote the multi-stakeholder model and bottom-up policy development process
- Coordinate and support joint RIR activities
- Act as a focal point for input into the RIR system
- Fulfill the role of the ICANN Address Supporting Organisation (ASO)

- **Montevideo Statement**
 - October 2013
- **NTIA Announcement**
 - March 2014
- **IANA Coordination Group**
 - June 2014
 - CRISP
- **IANA Transition plan**
 - March 2016
 - Followed by ICANN/NTIA/USG Reviews
- **IANA Contract Expiry**
 - 1 October 2016

After the Transition...

- **ICANN provides IANA Services**
 - For the foreseeable future
- **Service Level Agreement (SLA)**
 - For provision of IANA Services by ICANN to the RIRs
- **IANA IPR**
 - Transferred to IETF Trust
- **ICANN Accountability**
 - Continuing improvements (WS2)



Service Level Agreement

- **Contract between RIRs and ICANN**
 - For provision of IANA services
 - In full compliance with CRISP proposal
 - Final version signed during ICANN 56 in Helsinki and since October 1st 2016 in effect

- **Review Committee**
 - For oversight of performance under SLA
 - 15 members, 3 per RIR

IANA IPR

- **Intellectual Property Rights**
 - E.g. trademarks and domain names.
 - IETF Trust now hold the IANA IPR
- **Three agreements**
 - Assignment of IPR to IETF Trust
 - License of IPRs to ICANN
 - Community Agreement (RIRs as signatories)
- **Community Coordination Group (CCG)**
 - Provides guidance and advice to the IETF Trust regarding the stewardship of the IANA IPR
 - Nine members, three appointed by each of the Operational Communities
 - NRO EC officeholder will serve (chair, secretary, treasurer)

- RIR staff and Community members

- **Work Stream 2**

- Considering ICANN accountability improvements to be implemented after IANA Transition
- E.g. Diversity, Human Rights, Jurisdiction, SO/AC Accountability, Staff Accountability etc.
