- Advanced Connectivity Services


















IPv6 @ RCTS

- Native IPv6 since 2003
 - Tests since 1999
 - Production address block obtained in 2000
- Also serving MCTES and MIN-EDU
- · Very stable international IPv6 connectivity
- Hosting Google and Akamai cache nodes
 - IPv4 & **IPv6**

(and open to more!)











RCTS Members: How many?

- Total: 77
 - Universities: 24
 - Polytechnical Institutes: 15
 - Other: 38
- Members with IPv6 connection: 33 (~43%)
- Members with daily IPv6 traffic peak above 100Mbps: 9
- Members with average daily IPv6 traffic (0-24h) above 100Mbps: 1



IPv6 Addressing Plan


· /35 -> /32 -> **/29**


- Assignment of a /48 block to each member

Always use /64 prefixes in Local Networks





Traffic, IPv4 vs. IPv6 (8th June)
